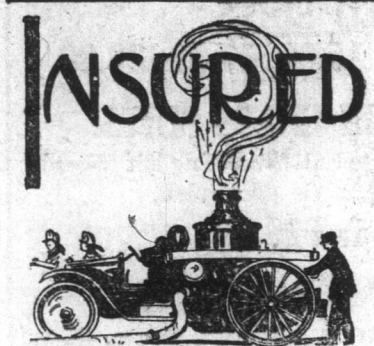

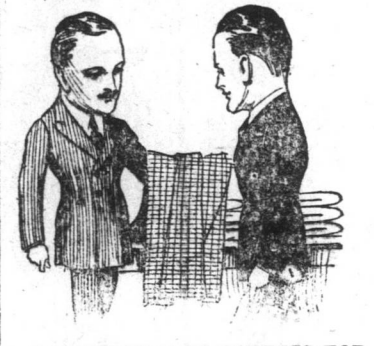

Running Broad Jump. 1. The length of the run is unlimited. Each competitor shall be allowed three jumps, and the five best shall be allowed three more jumps. Each competitor shall be credited with the best of all his jumps.

Pole Vault. 1. The height of the bar at starting and at each successive clearance shall be determined by the Field Judges. 2. Each competitor shall be allowed three jumps at each height, and the competitor who fails at the third attempt shall be disqualified.

THROWING THE DISCUS. 1. All throws to be valid, must fall within a 90 degree sector marked on the ground. 2. It shall be a foul throw if the competitor, after he has stepped into the circle and started to make his throw, touches with any part of his body or clothing the ground outside the circle before the discus strikes the ground. It shall also be a foul if the competitor steps on the circle.
