TO ALL CONCERNED.

Shippers or Consignees, when effecting marine insurance, should bear this in mind, and have their policies covered accordingly.

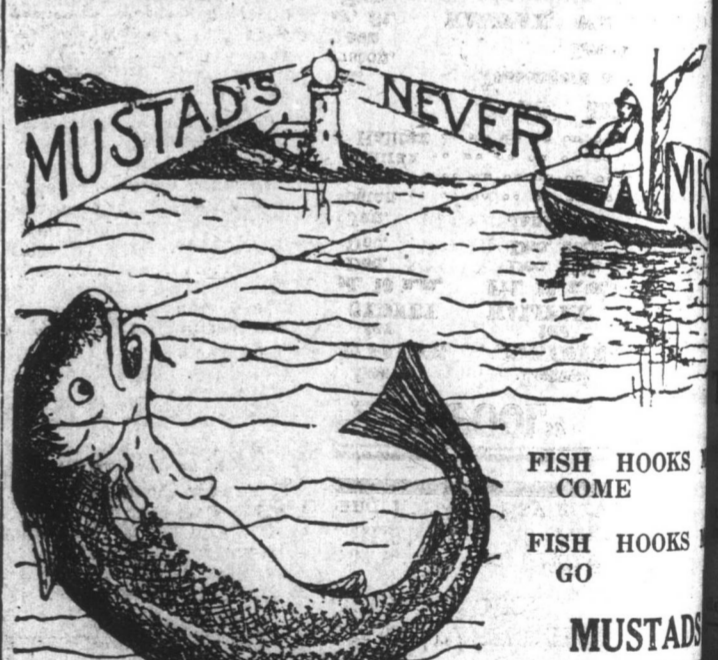
