## Town Council

(Continued from page 2.)

for the impartial and fair reports of the proceedings of the Council during the past year.

A resolution moved and seconded by Deputy Reeve Schiedel and Reeve Kaufman to the effect that copies of the financial statement for the year be printed, was also carried.

### Services Appreciated.

Councillor Kutt after the transaction of business referred to the retirement of Deputy Reeve Schiedel from the Council in order to accept the position of Manager of the Water, Light and Gas Departments. He spoke well of his past services to the Council and congratulated the Water, Light and Gas Commission for having secured such an able successor to the management of those departments.

Regarding the question of his seeking re-election Councillor Kutt stated that he would be a candidate for the Deputy Reveship.

Reeve Kaufman seconded Councillor Kutt's motion that a resolution of appreciation of the services of the chairman of the Finance Committee, Deputy Reeve Schiedel, be passed.

The other members of the Council agreed, with this opinion and took advantage of the occasion to state their intention regarding the seeking of re-election.

### Councillor Bricker.

"I will not be a candidate again. I have not the necessary time to devote to the town's interests. I am glad that such harmony has prevailed in the Council in the past year."

Councillor Meyer: "I will be a candidate. If elected I will be contented, and if not I will also be satisfied."

Councillor Ross: "I think that I will drop out for I am a busy man. Regarding the possibility of Mr. Kaufman's being Mayor, I can only say that he should get along well. In the matter of the two towns, I, however, have no objection against Mr. Kaufman."

Mayor Fischer (jocularly): "You are afraid of the amalgamation of the two towns coming about if Mr. Kaufman is elected."

Councillor Ross: "Not at all, for I am sure that such a proposal would not carry if voted on at Waterloo ratepayers. Let me say, however, that I appreciate the aggressiveness of Berlin. We require more of that here. I do not blame Berlin citizens for boosting Berlin. Were I a resident of Berlin I would boost Berlin. While I am a resident of Waterloo, I will boost Waterloo. We have one of the best towns in Canada, but we should have more aggressiveness."

Mayor Fischer: "Mr. Ross has just stated that he has to retire from the Council on account of business. Now, as Mr. Bricker has shown, they want to keep me in the Council and saddle me with the Reeveship and the Chairman-ship of the Board of Works, although I have been connected with town affairs since the eighties. I think that the proper course would be to pension me. Let me also state that I am sorry to see Mr. Schiedel retire from the Council, for he has rendered excellent services."

I also wish to thank the Town Clerk, Mr. Haight for the system and ease with which he has conducted the work at the meetings of the Council. He has saved the Council a great deal of work and the town many unnecessary expenditures. Regarding myself, I must say that I will not be with you next year. I will retire and be a free man for at least a year."

Deputy-Reeve Schiedel: "Gentlemen I feel myself highly flattered by the remarks that have been made regarding myself and my appointment to the management of the Water, Light and Gas Departments which, I have been informed, was made at the meeting of the Commission this afternoon. I agree with the Mayor in his reference to the services of the Town Clerk. I also am glad that the proceedings of the Council in the past year have been so harmonious. I myself have endeavored to do my duty and have been present at all the meetings with one exception. I discovered that my attention should be paid to the passing of accounts and as chairman of the Finance Committee I gave this matter more consideration."

The members present were Mayor Fischer, Reeve Kaufman, Deputy-Reeve Schiedel, Councillors Ross, Meyer, Bricker and Kutt. Adjournment was made at 10:30 o'clock.

### OLDEST ORANGEMAN DEAD.

Wm. Scott of Milverton Was In His Ninety-Fourth Year.

MILVERTON, Ont., Dec. 16.—Wm. Scott, the oldest Orangeman in the Province of Ontario, and probably in the Dominion of Canada, died at his home near here on Saturday, and his remains were interred in Greenwood Cemetery, Milverton, yesterday, under the auspices of the L.O.L. of the District of Mornington, of which he was for many years an honorary member. A large concourse of Orangemen were present, among them being Sheriff Magwood of Stratford, who took part in the service at the grave.

Mr. Scott was a native of Sligo, Ireland, and came to Canada in 1820. He is survived by his wife, but has no blood relations in America. He was in his ninety-fourth year and had been a member of the Orange Association for over seventy-four years.

### Committed For Trial.

ST. CATHARINES, Dec. 16.—Dr. Hall, veterinary surgeon and agent of the General Animal Insurance Co. for Grimsby, and Harry Smith of the same village, were yesterday committed for trial by Magistrate Campbell on the charge of conspiring to defraud the company out of \$500 on account of a stallion named Dea valued at \$1,500. No evidence was offered for the defence.

## SYNOPSIS OF DOMINION LAND REGULATIONS

Any person who is the sole sex of a family, or who has made over 10 years old, may homestead a quarter section of available Dominion land in Manitoba, Saskatchewan or Alberta. The applicant must appear in person at the Dominion Lands Agency of Sub-agency for the district. Entry by proxy may be made at any agency on certain conditions by father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister of intending home-seeker.

Deeds.—Six months' residence upon and cultivation of the land in each of the three years a homesteader may live within nine miles of his homestead on a farm of at least 80 acres, and be owned and occupied by him or by his father, mother, son, daughter, brother or sister.

In certain districts a home-seeker in good standing may pre-empt a quarter-section alone his homestead. Price \$2.00 per acre.

Deeds.—Must reside upon the homestead a pre-emption six months. No work of the year must date of homestead entry. In the three years required to earn homestead pre-emption a homesteader may erect a house worth \$500.00.
