The British commanders are reported afraid to allow their mariners to land for the purpose of parade at New York, for fear of desertions.

The long debate on Mr. Gladstone's home rule bill was concluded in the house of commons on April 21st, and the second reading of the bill passed by a majority of 47, the vote standing 347 for and 304 against.

Cablegrams were received at Rideau last Friday announcing the death of the Earl of Derby. Lord Stanley, the present governor-general, succeeds to the title.

Count Paul Hombroek, of Berlin, a brother of the prominent ultra-nationalist member of the reichstag, has publicly quit the Jesuit order, wherein he had occupied a high position for 13 years.

The lower house of the New York legislature has passed a bill providing for the abolition of capital punishment after Aug. 31 next. It was shown during the discussion of the measure that the ends of justice were often defeated through the severity of the sentence meted out to fit capital crimes.
