

(c) Any notification of accession under paragraph (a) of this article may include any dependency or mandated territory administered by the Government of the country in respect of which such notification of accession is given; and any notice of termination in respect of any such country under paragraph (b) shall apply to any dependency or mandated territory which was included in the notification of accession in respect of that country.

ARTICLE 16

(a) The High Contracting Parties agree that His Majesty the King of Great Britain, Ireland and the British Dominions beyond the Seas, Emperor of India, may at any time, while the present Convention is in force, either under article 14 or in virtue of any accession under this article, by a notification given through the diplomatic channel, refer to the present Convention in respect of any territory of the British Commonwealth of Nations whose Government may desire that such accession should be effected, provided that no notification of accession may be given at any time when the British Government has given notice of termination in respect of all the territories of His Majesty to which the Convention applies. The provisions of article 15 (b) shall be applicable in such notification. Any such accession shall take effect on receipt of the date of its notification.
