Maximum three months

### General

This program is designed for Canadian candidates who have graduated in disciplines related to Architecture, Engineering, Forestry or Urban Planning.

### Duration of training

Up to 18 months

### Conditions for admission

To be eligible applicants must:

- be graduates of a university or institute of technology or equivalent educational institution;
- have a minimum of one year's working experience directly related to their academic degree or diploma;
- undertake their period of training in their own profession or trade;
- be 18 to 30 years of age; and
- have a working knowledge of English, Finnish, Swedish or German (certificate from a language teacher needed if Finnish or English is not your mother tongue).

### Training areas

If you are a graduate in one of the fields mentioned above, we shall relay your application to the Finnish government which will undertake a job search on your behalf.
