1945, to December 31,
1946, will have lost
British status. A British
woman whose husband was
naturalized in France after
the 10th August, 1927,
retains British nationality.

- 3. <u>Honduras</u>: A woman who married a Hondurian on or after 15th April, 1936, retains British nationality.
- 4. Portugal: A woman who married a Portuguese subject outside Portugal retains British nationality unless the marriage was registered in Portugal.
- 5. <u>U.S.S.R.</u>: A woman who married any Russian
 (whether a Soviet citizen or a "White" Russian)
 after 7th November, 1917,
 or whose husband was naturalized in the U.S.S.R. after that date, retains
 British nationality.
- 6. Spain: A woman who married
 a Spanish national after
 the 9th December, 1931,
 retains British nationality,
 in the absence of option
