

Scholarships are for persons who wish to undertake a master's or doctoral programme at a Canadian university, or are enrolled in a master's or doctoral programme at a university in their home country and wish to carry out part of their research in Canada. Fellowships are for persons who wish to conduct post-doctoral research in Canada.

Most of the countries to which Canada offers these awards have similar programmes for Canadians. Information about these foreign awards may be obtained from the Association of Universities and Colleges of Canada, 151 Slater Street, Ottawa, K1P 5N1, except in the cases of Brazil, Italy, Japan and Sweden whose Embassies in Ottawa are the channels.
