## PRAYERS.

Mr. Bennett, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House, by command of His Excellency the Administrator,—Report of the Secretary of State for External Affairs for the year ended December 31, 1930.

Also,—Report of the Imperial Conference, 1930. Part I—Summary of Proceedings. Part II—Appendices to the Summary of Proceedings.—(English and French.)

On motion of Mr. Bennett it was ordered,—That 1,000 copies be printed in English and 700 copies in French of the Summary of Proceedings and Appendices of the Imperial Conference of 1930; and that Standing Order 64 be suspended in relation thereto.

Mr. Bennett, a Member of the King's Privy Council, laid before the House, by command of His Excellency the Administrator,—The Public Accounts of Canada, for the fiscal year ended March 31, 1930.
