when the relation between the Association and the University will be examined and revised if necessary.

(3) In case of Mr. Johnsen's retirement at any time, thus rendering the position filled by him vacant, the University undertakes to engage as his successor an expert agreeable to the Pulp & Paper Association. In fact, in the conduct of this Department we shall always appreciate the advice of the Association, and in this connection I would suggest that a small committee of, say, three be named by the Association to sit with a University committee to consider all matters pertaining to the work of the Department about to be inaugurated.
