— of <i>New York</i> .	
— of <i>New York</i> commenced the 22d of June, 1813. After public notification, the actual investment constitutes a complete blockade without further notice—REPUBLICAN, <i>Beaupin</i>	571
— where a Blockade has been known to exist, the Claimant must prove the relaxation; but where it is not known that a blockade has been commenced, it is for the Captors to establish it by evidence	
— Licensed vessels not affected by an Order for Blockade, when such appears to have been His Majesty's intention	
— Affects the Enemy only <i>de facto</i> —neutrals <i>de jure</i> —ORION, <i>Jubin</i>	497
— Where a blockade has been notified publicly, no further information is necessary; and if a vessel, knowing of such notification, sails to the Port, and finds it blockaded, it is a Breach of the Blockade—CARLOTTA, <i>Curvalho</i>	539
— Vessels associated for a Blockade, intitled to share in Captures of the Enemy's Property, though driven on Shore and seized there—FLIGHT, <i>Kelly</i>	559
