

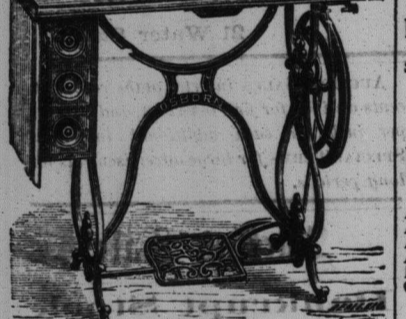

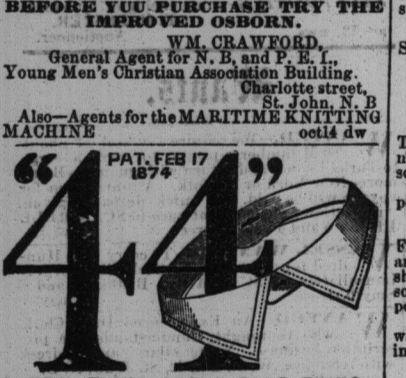

**Gregory vs. McQuade**—Appel allowed with costs.  
**Clark vs. Lake**—Rule absolute to quash.

**Bank of Nova Scotia vs. Eustachius & Gleason**—Judgment for defendants on demurrer.  
**Taylor & Dockrill vs. the Grand Truck Railway Co.**—Judgment of the City Court sustained.

**Lloyd vs. the Union Insurance Co.**—Rule absolute to return the policy.  
**White vs. Bellis**—Rule refused.

**Swan vs. Rankine et al.**—Rule nisi.  
**The European and North American Railway Co. vs. George McLeod**—The court will decide whether there will be a new trial or a verdict for the plaintiffs for the assessment of the land to be good.

This morning when the case of the Queen against Joshua was called, Mr. Tuck, for the Crown, asked that the trial be postponed till next week. A letter from Sgt.
