Bill (from the Legislative Council) for making mortgages special on all Lands and other real and immoveable property which now are or hereafter may be holden in free and common Soccage within this Province, and for establishing Register Offices for all Deeds and Mortgages relating to such Property therein.

TITHEREAS real property is depreciated

Preamble.

by being involved in dispute and uncertainty by the creation of general and prospective Mortgages, and also, by the difficulty. of coming at a knowledge of the incumbrances thereon, and whereas frauds have been and may be committed by giving mortgages to different persons and concealing the same: Be it therefore enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and Assembly of the Province of Lower-Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of Great Britain, intituled, An Act to repeal certain parts of an Act passed in the fourteenth year of His Majesty's Reign, intituled, 'An Act for ma-' king more effectual provision for the Govern-ment of the Province of Quebec, in North Ame-'rica,' and for making further provision for the Government of the said Province: And it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same that from and after the first day of January in the year of Our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven, no Acte or Deed in Law by which a Mortgage or Hypothéque is created, Judgments of the Courts of Law only excepted, shall bind or affect as a Mortgage or Hypothêque any Lands or other Immoveable Property situate within the limits of this Province, and held in free and common Soccage, unless such Acte or Deed be Notarial and shall have been duly enregistered in the manner hereinafter directed.

After the 1st May 1827 no Acte to affect as a Mortgage any Property held in Free and Common Soccage unless passed before Notary and enregistered &c.

Judgments excepted.

II. And be it further enacted by the authority aforesaid, that from and after the said first day of January in the year of our Lord one thousand eight hundred and twenty seven, no Acte or Deed whatsoever save and except such Judg.

After such time no Acte or Deed to feer a Mortgage on such Property unless passed before
