Note of Contents.

Text of Proclamation, 19th July, 1910 "touching
Royal Coronation and solemnity thereof".

" 7th November, 1910 "for
appointing a date for the celebration of
the solemnity of the coronation of Their
Majesties".

" 4th February, 1911 "for
appointing a day for the celebration in
H.M. Indian dominions for the solemnity
of the Coronation of His Majesty".

" 22nd March, 1911 "for
appointing Thursday, 22nd June and Friday, 23rd
June, 1911 Bank Holidays and Public Holidays
throughout the United Kingdom and in the
County of London, respectively".

" 4th May, 1911 "for removing
doubts as to the effect of the Royal Proclam-
ation of 22nd March last appointing Friday,
23rd June next a Bank Holiday and Public
Holiday in the County of London".
