I beg to acknowledge receipt of your statement of medical attendance given to Indians at the Hospital at Baie des Peres for the half year ended 31st December last, and have to inform you that the Department does not consider that it would be justified in paying a grant of \$50.00 to this hospital for the period named when assistance was given to only one Indian for 5 days. It is also thought that the complaint from which the patient suffered was not of sufficient importance to render it necessary that she should have been admitted to the hospital at all.
