



Sir,

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 18th. instant referring to the registration of the plan of Lestock, and in reply have to say that the said plan was duly sent to the Registrar of land Titles for registration but was returned to the Department for the purpose of making certain amendments thereto required by the Provincial Act. As the amendments requested would constitute a precedent and were of some importance, it was decided to request the advice of the Department of Justice. On the receipt of the said advice further action will be taken in connection with the registration of the said plan.
