Sir,-

I beg to inform you that the Department has decided to dispense with the services of Mr. R. B. Irvine, Farm Instructor for the Sakimay Band of Indians, Crooked Lakes Reserve. It is, therefore, desired that you will give him one month's notice to the above effect. You should attend to this matter immediately upon receipt of this letter.

The Department proposes to employ Mr. F. L. Deacon Grenfell, Sask., as successor to Mr. Irvine. The employment will be on probation. I transmit herewith a form of application for appointment, which should be filled in by Mr. Deacon. Kindly send it to him and have him fill it in, after which you should forward it to the Department. When Mr. Irvine leaves, Mr. Deacon should take over the work, and you should give him all necessary instructions in regard thereto. He will be paid at the same rate as Mr. Irvine viz:- \$50.00 a month.
