10. Women's Wages

The Economic Advisory Committee has not had time to consider the recommendations of the Reports on this subject nor has it any special competence in considering the problem. It merely directs the attention of the Government to the recommendation of the Department of Labour Committee that the War Labour Board shall, in general, deal with the wages of female workers upon the same basis as of male workers with such modifications as the nature of the individual case may require.
