

thereon, and to become responsible to His Majesty for the faithful performance by their respective bands of such obligations as shall be assumed by them, the said Indians have therefore acknowledged for that purpose the several Chiefs and Headmen who have subscribed hereto.

AND WHEREAS the said Commissioner has proceeded to negotiate a treaty with the Slave, Fogorik, Pombare, Gore and other Indians inhabiting the district hereinafter defined and described, which has been agreed upon and concluded by the respective bands or the States mentioned hereunder, the said Indians do herebycede, Release, Surrender, and yield up to the Government of the Dominion of Canada, for His Majesty the King and his Successors forever, all their rights, titles, and privileges whatsoever to the lands included within the following limits, that is to say :-

COMMENCING at the North-westerly corner of the territory ceded under the provisions of Treaty Number Eight; thence North-easterly along the height-of-land to the point where it intersects the boundary between the Hudson Territory and the North West Territories; thence North-westerly along the said boundary to the shore of the
