

whereon, and to become responsible to His Majesty for the faithful performance by their respective bands of such obligations as shall be assumed by them, the said Indians have therefore assembled for that purpose the several Chiefs and Headmen who have subscribed thereto.

WITNESSED The said Commissioners had proceeded to negotiate a treaty with the Slave, Dogrib, Loucheux, Slave and other Indians inhabiting the district hereinbefore defined and described, which has been agreed upon and concluded by the respective bands at the dates mentioned hereunder, the said Indians so hereby cede, release, surrender, and yield up to the Government of the Dominion of Canada, for His Majesty the King and his successors forever, all their rights, title, and privileges whatsoever to the lands included within the following limits, that is to say: -

COMMENCING at the North-westerly corner of the territory described under the provisions of Treaty Number Eight; thence North-westerly along the head-of-land to the point where it intersects the boundary between the Union Territories and the North West Territories; thence North-westerly along the said boundary to the shore of the
