



A COW THAT HAS SMASHED ALL RECORDS FOR MILK PRODUCTION

The splendid possibilities of milk production are abundantly demonstrated in the record of this cow, Missouri Chief Josephine, a Holstein cow that, in six months ending July 18th last, produced 17,009 pounds of milk, being an average of 93.4 pounds of milk adily for 182 days. In eight months she produced 21,698 pounds of milk. Her record is not yet complete for one year. In his address at Perth last week, which is published on page 5, Chas. F. Whitely sets forth some astounding facts, which show that greatly increased production is possible for every man who keeps dairy cows.
