NEW HIGH RECORDS MADE BY SUN LIFE

NEW BUSINESS WRITTEN LAST YEAR TOTALLED \$100,000,000

ASSETS ALSO OVER HUNDRED MILLION MARK

A new high record in applications for assurance policies was attained by the Sun Life Assurance Company of Canada during the past year, according to the 49th Annual Report of the Company just issued.

A new record was also made in the new business actually issued and paid for, which totalled \$86,548,850, an increase over the previous year of \$84,957,457 or 67.7%.

One record after another appears to have been made by this company. The total business in force reached the huge total of \$116,858,462 showing an increase of \$75,548,805 over 1918.

The assets of the company exceeded the hundred million mark, being \$105,711,468, a gain of \$8,091,059. Income totalled \$25,704,201, a gain of \$4,063,101, surplus at December 31st was \$8,037,440; while profits paid and allotted amounted to \$1,506,503. The sum paid to policy-holders was \$12,364,000, bring the total for this department since organization up to \$91,237,832
