## OBITUARY

William McKittrick

The death occurred at his residence, Belcher St., on Saturday, Aug. 5th, of **William McKittrick**, son of the late John and Abigail Newcombe McKittrick, at the age of sixty-four years.

Although not in the best of health the past month, his sudden prostration at Berwick on July 26th from which he never fully regained consciousness, followed by his death ten days later, came as a shock to the whole community, and more particularly to the home in which his bright and happy life will be so much missed.

In such a way has the Grim Reaper seen fit to remove from his sphere of usefulness, a man beloved alike by rich and poor and whose heart and hand were ever ready to help the one in trouble.

Since boyhood Mr. McKittrick has been interested in farming and by his skill and industry has built up one of the finest farms of the Cornwallis district. Of late years his attention has been more closely confined to orcharding, and it was perhaps his interest in the fruit-growing conditions of the Province that hastened the end.

During the past two years he was president of the Kentville Fruit Co., and a member of the executive of the United Fruit Co., Berwick.

His time, however, was not all given to this large industry, but his influence was widely felt in the civic and religious life of the town. For two terms his fellow citizens elected him as Councillor, and the past three years he has been town assessor.

St Paul's Presbyterian church of which he had long been a member has for many years honored him with the office of trustee.

He leaves to mourn his loss a wife and two daughters, Misses Lillian and Gertrude; also four sisters, Miss Agnes McKittrick, Mrs. Leonard Cogswell, Mrs. Dexter Collins, and Mrs. Joseph Harris.

The funeral services which were held at his late residence on Monday afternoon at three o'clock were very largely attended, and many floral offerings testified to the esteem in which the deceased was held; Family—Pillow, carnations and sweet-peas.
