

KING MAY VISIT DOMINION
DURING THE SUMMER OF 1914Trip Likely To Be Timed for
Opening of the National
Transcontinental.

Ottawa, Jan. 2. — There is reason to believe that His Majesty the King may visit Canada in the summer of 1914 to formally open for traffic the National Transcontinental Railway between Halifax and Prince Rupert.

Officials of the Grand Trunk Pacific declare there is no foundation for the rumor that the Grand Trunk Pacific may repudiate its contract with the Government respecting the lease of the road between Moncton and Winnipeg. They say, on the contrary, that the Grand Trunk Pacific will be ready to operate the entire Transcontinental line as soon as completed, and opening ceremonies are already being planned upon a scale of unusual magnificence. It is well known that His Majesty intends to visit the Dominion in the near future, and it is hoped that his visit may be so timed as to enable him to cross the continent upon the first through train from Halifax to Prince Rupert.

ALFRED DICKENS
DIES IN NEW YORK

Had Come to America to Lecture
About His Famous
Father.

HE DIES SUDDENLY

Was Dictating a Letter to His Secretary When Seized With Fatal Illness.

New York, Jan. 2.—Alfred Tennyson Dickens, who was the eldest surviving son of Charles Dickens, the novelist, and a grandson of Tennyson, died suddenly in his apartment at the Hotel Astor between 5 and 6 o'clock this evening. Mr. Dickens, who recently came here from Australia, after lecturing for a year in England, suffered a slight attack of indigestion on Monday night, but was able to walk about the hotel lobby this forenoon.

While in the lobby, however, he had a sudden attack of weakness. Dr. Burt, the hotel physician, who had relieved Mr. Dickens the night before, advised the lecturer to send word to Kingston, where he was to have lectured tonight, that the lecture would have to be postponed. When Dr. Burt further advised that Mr. Dickens spend the day resting quietly.

He was dictating a letter from the hotel to his secretary shortly after 5 o'clock when he was seized with fatal illness. It is presumed that he had fallen asleep, and that the men would follow as soon as necessary.

THE WATERWAYS BOARD

New Canadian Section Holds Its First Meeting at Montreal.

Montreal, Jan. 2.—A formal meeting of the newly-appointed Canadian section of the international high joint commission was held in the city today, preparatory to the convening of the body in Washington on Jan. 10.

The new commission, the Canadian members of which are Messrs. T. Chase Casgrain, K.C., of this city; C. A. Magrath, of Medicine Hat, and H. A. Powell, of John, N. B., has been formed under the terms of the general treaty between Great Britain and the United States made two years ago. One of the greatest problems which the international commission will be called upon to project of damming the Long Sault Rapids. The Long Sault Development Company, of which the Pittsburgh Aluminum Company is the principal shareholder, has a bill before the United States Senate asking for the necessary authorization to carry out the proposed work of building a huge dam, which is to harness the power of the greatest of the St. Lawrence rapids. There has, however, been strong opposition to the scheme at Washington, and a determined effort will be made by the opponents of the measure to have the matter referred to the new international commission. The meeting today was private and no announcements were made.
