They must understand the care and management of horses, and be able to ride well.

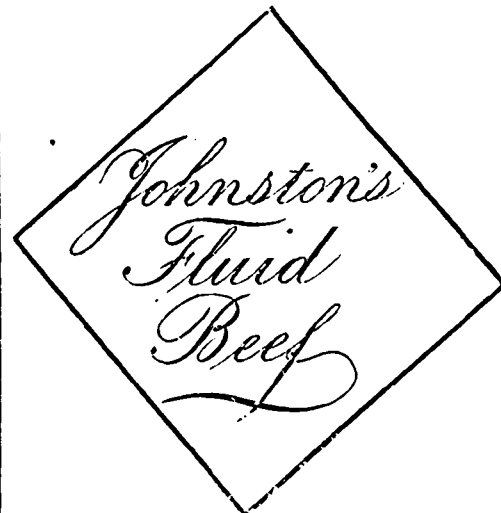
