

Financial assistance is provided for the cost of international transportation and a monthly living allowance of approximately \$350. The Mexican Government pays all expenses related to medical and emergency dental care; life and accident insurance; supplementary language training, if required, and traineeship related academic courses and transportation.

### **Exchange of Public Servants: France-Canada**

This program enables Canadian and French officials to learn administrative techniques of the other country's public service through courses and periods of work experience. It is administered by the Public Service Commission of Canada and organized in conjunction with the École nationale d'administration in Paris.

Canadian public servants are selected to attend courses at the École nationale d'administration for one year and an equal number of French public servants are brought to Canada for a work period in a federal or provincial department.
