## GRANTS TO CLASS A FAIRS

## Question No. 1037—Mr. Dinsdale:

1. What funds are made available by the government of Canada to class A fairs?
2. How have these funds been disbursed to each class A fair for each year since 1963?
3. What programs are contemplated for the fiscal year 1966-67?

**Hon. J. J. Greene (Minister of Agriculture):**

1. Funds are available to each class "A" exhibition in respect to the following, on an annual basis:

(a) *Permanent improvement grants* for the building, repair or alterations of facilities

for the display of agricultural products or improvements to exhibition grounds. This grant is based on 50 per cent of actual expenditure to a maximum of \$3,000.

(b) *Grants with respect to judges.* This is a total expenditure grant for payment to judges of specified agricultural exhibits to a maximum of \$500.

(c) *Junior activities grants.* A total expenditure grant to pay for transportation of club exhibits, accommodation and meals of exhibitors, trophies and prize monies on interclub competitions. Maximum grant \$1,000.

(d) *Prize money grants.* Class "A" exhibitions showing under the new livestock classifications receive 50 per cent of the prize money paid out in the new classes.

*Major capital grants*

Major capital grants are paid in respect to agreements made effective prior to June 21, 1962.
