

## BY-LAW

*To raise the sum of £50 in the Townships of Aldborough and Mosa, for the purpose of assisting to erect a Bridge across the River Thames at Wardsville.*

[Passed 7th February, 1838.]

**WHEREAS** it is expedient to raise the sum of fifty pounds in the Townships of Aldborough and Mosa towards defraying the expense of erecting a Bridge across the River Thames at Wardsville—it is therefore hereby enacted by the Council of the London District, that the sum of fifty pounds shall be raised on the taxable property in said Township for the purposes abovementioned.

And it is further enacted, That the above sum shall be raised, levied, collected and paid over to the District Treasurer in the same manner as other rates have heretofore been raised, levied, collected and paid over; and the Clerk of the Peace is hereby authorized and required to impose said assessment over and above the expenses of collecting the same, by placing the same upon the proper collector's roll for this year in a separate column; or such part of said assessment as can be collected, having regard to the limitation of the powers of this Council of imposing taxes.
