An Act to amend the Dominion Elections Act, 1900.

HIS Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Senate and House of Commons of Canada, enacts as follows :—

1. Subsection 6 of section 48 of *The Dominion Elections Act*, 1900, c. 12, is repealed, and the following is substituted therefor :—

“6. The back of the ballot papers shall bear the name of the printer who prints them.”

2. Form P of the said Act is amended by adding after the words “*Counterfoil to be here*” the following words :—“*the face of which shall be entirely black, similar to the broad black lines across the ballot.*”

3. Form P is further amended by transferring to the back of the ballot paper the following words :—“*Election of the Electoral District of....., 19 Ballot paper,*” and all other words which are placed over the names of the candidates in the compartment known as the heading to the said ballot form.
