2nd. To aid in the establishment and main tenance of Homes for aged and indigent Odd Fellows and their wives, and for the widows of deceased Odd Fellows; and Homes for the care, education, and support of orphans of deceased Odd Fellows, and of deceased sisters of the Rebekah Degree.

3rd. To cultivate and extend the social and fraternal relations of life among Lodges and the families of Odd Fellows and Rebekahs.

ARTICLE III.

Membership

- Sec. 1. The persons specified herein may become members of this Lodge upon proper application.
- 1. All persons who have received the Degree of Rebekah.
- 2. All Odd Fellows in good standing and their wives, daughters, sisters, and mothers, also the daughters, sisters and mothers of deceased Odd Fellows who at the time of their death were members of our Order in good standing.
- 3. All unmarried white women who have attained the age of eighteen years.
