as shall appear most probable speedily to ensure the acquisition of the naval ascendency.

You are already acquainted with the decided line of conduct which I wish to be observed on Lake Erie, by capt. Barclay, and you will not fail to impress on that officer the absolute necessity of regaining the naval superiority, and to preserve uninterrupted the intercourse between Ambersiourg and Long Point, in order that the supplies and stores in depot at the latter place, and at the head of the lake, may be transported in safety to the Right Division.

The flotilla of transports on Lake Ontario are to be kept employed, as long as the season will admit, in the conveyance of the provisions and other supplies collected at Kingston, and destined for the Right and Centre Divisions of the army, and they are to receive from your force the necessary protection.
