Sec. 7.—At all elections of local officers the presiding officer shall appoint two tellers. He shall then announce the names of the candidates in rotation, and a vote shall be taken.

Sec. 8.—The tellers shall then collect and count the ballots cast in the presence of the meeting. The Recording Secretary shall act as Clerk of Election, and shall take charge of the ballots and preserve the same until after the installation of officers. The presiding officer shall declare the result of the ballot and announce the name of the elected candidate.

Sec. 9.—The election of officers shall take place on the second meeting night in June.

Sec. 10.—The installation of officers shall take place on the first meeting night in July. In case an officer does not appear for installation within two regular meetings thereafter, his office must be declared vacant.
