MINES TO GOVERN

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MINES Railway Chief Mines Limited have been granted a lease of a certain mineral claim on the Upper Chalkwater Reserve No. 2, known as the "Gold Creek" claim, having an area of 21.25 acres, by the District Gold Commissioner, prior to August 31st, 1938.

AND WHEREAS the current annual rental at the rate of 50 cents per acre, amounting to \$107.50 has been paid.

Permission is hereby given to use and occupy the said land for mining development purposes only, during the term of the aforesaid mineral lease, dating from the First day of January 1938, provided the annual rental of \$107.50 is paid in advance each year.
