(Canadian Press.) Ottawa, May 1-The commercial treaty with France came up once again yesterday afternoon in the committee Rt. Hon. Arthur Meighen said the distillers of rye whiskey in Canada were placed at a disadvantage by the

were placed at a disadvantage by the reduction given on the importation of French brandy. There were many Canadians opposed to the continued manufacture of rye whiskey, but Mr. Meighen did not believe that this was the way to end it. Hon. W. S. Fielding said that if, as a consequence of the treaty any home industry was threatened that matter would receive consideration and attention if it was thought necessary. Only a small proportion of French brandy would be affected and this was a spec-

Clauses two to eight of the treaty carried with very little debate. Answering Dr. Murray MacLaren, Conservative, St. John, Mr. Fielding said French goods coming in via American ports would not come under the treaty. Committee stage was concluded and the bill reported.
