### FIND RED ARMY IN GERMANY

Berlin, Jan. 24.—A semi-official statement says that evidence of the existence of a red army, created by the German communist party, has been revealed by house searches in Essen, Dusseldorf, Elberfeld and Bremen. Berlin, it says, is the military headquarters. It declares that the red army possesses light and heavy guns in vast quantities, and other war material.

Action was scheduled to begin at the conclusion of the recent strike at the smelters at Hamburg, but it was postponed for a fortnight.

A report from Dusseldorf says the general of the red army has been arrested.
