### GOVERNOR TWEEDIE IN MONTREAL

(Montreal Herald)

Lieut. Governor Tweedie of New Brunswick, is now at the Windsor awaiting the arrival from Prince Rupert of his daughter, who will spend the winter at his home in Chatham, N. B.

Mr. Tweedie has been governor of New Brunswick for five years past. When his term expires on March 12 next he will devote his sole attention to the legal practice which he discontinued to accept the appointment as governor. Previous to that he was premier of his province.

Speaking last evening of the lumber industry in New Brunswick, Governor Tweedie said that fully sixty million feet of lumber was still lying up on the Miramichi from last year's cut. The reason was that the prices for deals had not been as high as the operators in that section of the province would accept.
