

1. Every officer will be a member of the Mess, and every unmarried officer or attached officer will be a regular dining member.

2. The Mess expenses will be controled by a committee of four officers of the corps, one of whom may be an attached officer for a long course.

The committee will consist of one President, one Secretary-Treasurer and two members.

This committee will be appointed for six months, every 21 day of January and July of each year. They will be responsible that the mess rules are not infringed, and the expenses are kept within limits.

3. The commandant being invested with the general superintendance of the regimental funds no expenditure larger than \$20 will be incurred without his sanction.

4. Married officers, except the commandant, will be required to dine at the Mess once a week on guest night.

5. Thursday will be the Guest night of the corps.

On Thursdays, every officer regular member of the Mess, will be at liberty to invite one or two guests whose expenses shall be paid by the
