An Act to provide by one General Law for the Incorporation of Electric Telegraph Companies.

TATHEREAS it is expedient to provide by one General Law Preamble. for the Incorporation and regulation of Companies formed. for the purpose of constructing lines of Electric Telegraphs in this Province: Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excel-5 lent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Canada, constituted and assembled by virtue of and under the authority of an Act passed in the Parliament of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland, and intituled, An Act 10 to re-unite the Provinces of Upper and Lower Canada, and for the Government of Canada, and it is hereby enacted by the authority of the same, That-

I. Any number of persons, not less than three, may associate Associations for the purpose of constructing a line or lines of Electric Tele-may be form-15 graph, with branches leading to and from the same, from and ed. to any point in this Province, upon the terms and conditions, and subject to the liabilities prescribed in this Act.

11. Such persons under, their hands and seals, shall make a Certificate to Certificate which shall specify:

- 20 1st. The name assumed to distinguish such Association, and to be used in its dealings, and by which it may sue and be sued, and a designation of the line or lines of Telegraph to be constructed by such association, and the route or routes by which such lines are to pass.
- 25 2dly. The capital stock of such Association, and the number of shares into which the stock shall be divided, and any provision which may be made for increasing the same, the names of the Shareholders, and the amount of stock held by
- 3dly. The period at which said Association shall commence and terminate:-

4thly. A copy of their Articles of Association.

And such certificate shall be acknowledged before a Notary, and the original or a copy thereof, certified by such Notary, \$5 shall be filed in the office of the Secretary of the Province.

III. Upon complying with the provisions of the last preced-Incorporation. ing section, such Association shall be and is hereby declared to be a Body Corporate by the name so as aforesaid to be designated in the said Certificate, and a copy of such Certificate
