

deposit one copy thereof with the Register of the County of Lincoln and the other in the office of the Commissioner of Crown Lands; and the decision of the said Commissioners shall be final: Provided always, that the said Commissioners may cause stone boundaries to be placed to mark the position of the Road allowance in such places (if any) as they shall think necessary: Provided also that any person or persons who, after any allowance for Road shall have been established according to this Act, shall be found to have made improvements on the said allowance for Road shall not be compelled to give up possession thereof until the Municipal Council of the said Township shall have paid or tendered the value of the said improvements.

V. And be it enacted, that the Municipal Council of the said Township shall cause an estimate of the sum requisite to defray the expences to be necessarily incurred in carrying this Act into effect to be laid before them in order that the same may be levied on the proprietors of lands in the said Concessions in proportion to the quantity of land held by them respectively therein; and the said expences shall be paid by the Township Treasurer on the certificate and order of the Commissioner of Crown Lands.

VI. And be it enacted, that any two of the Commissioners under this Act, of whom the Deputy Provincial Surveyor appointed by the Commissioner of Crown Lands shall be one, may exercise all or any of the powers vested in the said Commissioners, and any award made or other thing done by any such two of them as aforesaid shall have force and effect as if made or done by the three Commissioners.

VII. And be it enacted, that this Act shall be a public Act.
