

BILL.

An Act to incorporate certain persons
under the name of *The Quebec For-*
warding Company.

WHEREAS Henry John Noad, James Preamble.
Gibb, T. H. Dunn, Henry LeMes-
nier, and William Stevenson, by their humble
Petition in this behalf, have represented that
5 an Association has been formed in the City
of Quebec, in which they and others have
become Subscribers and Stockholders for the
purpose of transporting Goods, Merchandize
and Passengers, from and to Quebec, Lake
10 Champlain, the Upper Lakes, and other pla-
ces, that the Capital Stock of the said Asso-
ciation is limited to forty thousand pounds
current money of this Province, divided into
15 each, that one hundred and fifty-four shares
have been subscribed, and that the full
amount thereof, to wit, the sum of fifteen
thousand four hundred pounds said current
money, has been paid in, and is held by the
20 said Association, and have prayed that for
the better effecting the purposes of their As-
sociation, they, their successors and assigns, be
incorporated; And whereas the said Associa-
has built and bought divers steam vessels and
25 barges, and has successfully prosecuted the
said undertaking for about six years, under
the name of "The Québec Forwarding Com-
pany"; And whereas divers debts are now
due to them by divers parties who have con-
30 tracted with them, in the enforcing payment
of which debts technical difficulties have
arisen, by reason of the multiplicity of the
names of the parties interested in the said
Association; And whereas also, divers indi-
35 vidual members of the said Association have
