## CENTREPIECE WITH TATTED BORDER

The edge requires about one box (10 balls) No. 10 crochet thread.

Abbreviations.—Double Stitch (d s). Chain (ch). Picot (p). Ring (r). Separate (sep).

Centre of Large Medallion.—Three yards of thread on shuttle. Ring 6 d s, small p, 6 d s, large p, 6 d s, small p, 6 d s. Chain 3 d s, small p, 3 d s, small p, 3 d s, repeat, join r to last r by 1st and 2d p. Make 8 centre rings, all joining 2d p of 1st ring.

For outside row.—6 yards on shuttle. Ring 3 d s, small p, 2 d s, join to ch (Note. The chain is made 4 stitches first half of d s, 4 stiches second half 1-4 s, small p, 1-4 s, p, 1-4 s, small p, join last row 4 d s, p, 8 d s. 1-4 s, join to 3rd p, 1-4 s, small p, 1-4 s, as first directions given.

8 d s, join last ring, 4 d s, join 2d r of last row, 8 d s; r 8 d s, join next r of last row, 4 d s, p, 8 d s, repeat to opposite the 4th point from where last row left off, then ch 8-4 s, 2 rings, ch 8-4 s; r 7 d s, join, 3 d s, join, 7 d s; r 7 d s, join 3 d s, p, 7 d s; ch 5-4 s, join to small med, 5-4 s; r 8 d s, join last r, 4 d s, join last row, 8 d s; r 8 d s, join, 4 d s, p, 8 d s; ch 4-4 s, join 2d point of small med, 4-4 s, repeat around med until 10 points are joined, then ch 5-4 s, join 11th point, 5-4 s; r 7 d s, join, 3 d s, p, 7 d s; r 7 d s, p, 7 d s; ch ch 8-4 s; r 8 d s, join, 4 d s, p, 7 d s; ch 8-4 s; r 8 d s, join, 4 d s, ch 4-4 s, join ch of 4th point on large med 4-4 s; r 8 d s, join, 4 d s, p, 8 d s; of centre, 2 d s, small p, 3 d s. Chain. r 8 d s, p, 4 d s, p, 8 d s; ch 4-4 s, join next ch, 5-4 s; r 8 d s, join, 4 d s, p, 8 d s. Drop second shuttle and take up of d s, 1-4 s means 4 stitches ½ of first again. Ring 8 d s, join, 4 d s, p, double. The 1st, 3rd, 5th, 7th, and 9th 8 d s; ch 8-4 s; r 4 d s, join last r, 4 first again. Ring 8 d s, join, 4 d s, p, p gradually increase in size from an ds, p, 4 ds; ch 8-4 s; r 8 ds, join last ordinary size to 1/4 inch). 1-4 s, p, r, 4 d s, join last row, 8 d s; r 8 d s, 1-4 s, p, 1-4 s, small p, 1-4 s, p, 1-4 s, around. There should be 7 small rings small p, 1-4 s, p, 8-4 s, turn work, between 2 large rings. After making join to last p or 9th p, 1-4 s, small p, last 2 large rings, ch 5-4 s, join second 1-4 s, join to 7th p, 1-4 s, small p, large med, 4-4 s; r 7 d s, join, 3 d s, join, 1-4 s, join to 5th p, 1-4 s, small p, 7 d s. Repeat around second med same









Small Medallion. - One and onehalf yards on shuttle. Ring 3 d s, 11 small p's with 3 d s between. Chain 1-4 s, p, 1-4 s, small p, 1-4 s, p, 1-4 s, small p, 1-4 s, p, 1-4 s, small p, 1-4 s, p. 6-4 s. turn work. join to 7th p, 1-4 s, small p, 1.4 s, join to 5th p, 1.4 s, small p, 1-4 s, join to 3rd p, 1-4 s, small p. 1-4 s, join to 1st p, 1-4 s. join with shuttle thread to centre ring. Repeat chain, joining 2d, 4th, and 6th p to small p of last chain.

Small medallion finished should measure 2% inches. Large medallion, 41/4

Edge.—Ring 7 d s, p, 3 d s, p, 7 d s; ch 3-4 s, join to point of large med, 3-4 s; r 7 d s, join to last r, 3 d s, p, 7 d s: r 7 d s, p, 3 d s, p, 7 d s, repeat until 20 points are joined, ch 4-4 s, join to next point, 5-4 s: r 8 d s, join to last r. 4 d s, p, 8 d s. With 2d shuttle and thread r 8 d s, join p of 1st ring of last row, 4 d s, p, 8 d s; ch 9-4 s; r



Chain 6, t in 1st ch st, ch 13, t in 6th st from hook, ch 8, turn. 2d rowd in loop, ch 5, (3 d, ch 4, 3 d) on 6 ch, ch 5, d in loop, ch 8, turn. 3rd rowd in loop, ch 6, d in loop, ch 5, d in loop, ch 8, turn.
