MUSCOW, SASK. NOVEMBER 12, 1940.

We, the undersigned, Chief and Councillors of the
Pasqua.....Band of Indians owning the Reserve situated
at.....MUSCOW....., in the....QU'APPELLE.....
Indian Agency, in the Province ofSASKATCHEWAN.....
at a council summoned for the purpose, according to the rules
of the Band, and held on the said Reserve, this...12.....day
of...NOVEMBER....., A.D.1940, in the presence of the Indian
Agent for the said Reserve, representing thereat the Minister
of Mines and Resources for the Dominion of Canada;

Do hereby for ourselves, and on behalf of the Indian owners
of the said Reserve, request that a sum not exceeding...Two
hundred and ten dollars.....Dollars, be paid out of money
standing to the credit of this Band, for the purpose of an
amount of \$75 to be used for improving the homes on the reserve,
\$60.00 to purchase 1200 pickets at 05¢ each to fence the
north boundary of the reserve; \$50 to be used for travelling
expenses of Indians representing the band, and \$22.00 for
wages for road work done on the reserve.
