McDowell, J26136, carried out a forced landing in a field when demonstrating an emergency takeoff to R188368 LAC Shilton, R.H. C-2 category accident to Harvard #2703. No injury. Site of incident - $\frac{5}{2}$ mile east of R.2, Edwards Field. W.D. Softball team from No. 7 "M" Depot, Rockcliffe, were the guests of W.D. softball team at Uplands. Teams were closely matched, and the game was very interesting. The score - Rockcliffe 5, Uplands 0. Visiting team were taken swimming after which refreshments were served in the Mess Hall.
