I have to acknowledge the receipt of your communication of the 17th instant, relating to the visit of Mr. George Kaboosa with regard to the License covering certain timber on the northern part of the Reserve, and in reply to inform you that he has been here and submitted his views on the question of the boundary which has been taken into consideration, but the advisability urged by him of terminating the License covering the area in question cannot be entertained at present.
