Sir,-

The Department has to request that you will inspect the supplies which the Hudson's Bay Co. is to supply for the Indians of Norway House and other points North in Treaty No. 5.

The quality of flour, tem and twine should be equal to the standard samples in your office, and the bacon, rice and rolled oats of the quality and put up in the manner described in the index of Schedule of Indian supplies.

The other articles should be the best quality the Canadian market affords.

A copy of the Company's contract can be obtained from Mr. Inspector Semmens for the purpose of inspection.

You will also furnish Mr. Semmens from the stock in the warehouse a 25 lb. chest of Tea to be charged to the Dear Dake Indians.
