



Ottawa, 2nd February, 1905.

Gentlemen,

With reference to the concluding paragraph of your letter of the 28th ultimo, I beg to say that your account dated the 4th November for 50 sacks of flour supplied for the Carlton Agency, was paid by cheque No 3091, for the reason that the Agent reported that the sacks contained only 98 lbs (not 100) net. Owing to this fact your account was reduced by \$2.81- and the cheque sent you was drawn for \$137.69.
