

Ottawa, July 19, 1910.

I have to acknowledge the receipt of applications for the admission of five pupils to the Clayoquot Industrial school.

In reply I beg to say that the applications and certificates of health are all satisfactory and on these grounds there is no objection to the admission of these children.

The Principal is, however, carrying a number of children over and above that for which the grant is provided by the Department and the wisdom of carrying too many in excess of the number for which the per capita grant is allowed might be questioned, as these extra pupils will be quite a drain upon the finances of the institution. This is, however, a matter for the Principal himself to decide upon so long as there is ample accommodation and it is understood that the Department is in no way responsible.
