Sir,-

The Department is in receipt of a communication from Rev. R.F. Macdougall, in which he states that he and Mrs. Macdougall will take up their work on the John Smith's reserve at an early date.

Mr. Macdougall has been asked to communicate with you and told that you will give him necessary instructions as to their duties. Knowing the interest that you take in school work, the Department feels disposed to leave the matter in your hands.

In reference to the mid-day meal I desire to say that it is the wish of the Department to furnish only a very simple lunch to supplement that brought from home by the children. I would ask you, therefore, to have Mrs. Macdougall report monthly, showing the cost of supplies used in the meal and the number of meals served.

It is hoped that Mr. and Mrs. Macdougall will be enabled to attain a large measure of success and, with your co-operation, which the Department is confident they will receive, good results are looked for.
