
Ottawa, January 3, 1914.

Sir,-

I beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 26th ultimo, inclosing one copy of surrender of 30 acres of flooded land on Indian Reserve 61 A, to be exchanged for other land, and in reply to say that the Department is surprised that you have failed to carry out specific instructions given on the 11th ultimo. You were instructed to return both documents to the Department, while you have only returned one.
