Referring to your letter of the 15th instant, relative to certain articles required in connection with the Kuper Island Industrial School: I beg to say that you are hereby authorized to purchase twenty sacks of cement to be used in the construction of steps in front of the school and leading to the wharf, etc.

You may also purchase the paint, putty, turpentine and paint brushes required for painting the barn in connection with the school.

A land roller may be procured, the cost of which you state will be about \$114.00.

Competitive prices should be had in each case before purchase is made. The Department will take steps to have you provided with medicines which are required for use on behalf of the pupils of the school.
